1. The student will:
 - abide by the rules of the exchange organisers
 - accept the advice and supervision of his/her host family
 - attend his/her German partner's school regularly, abide by normal German school discipline and take an active part in school activities
 - NOT undertake travel in Europe under his/her own initiative
 - make every effort to speak German whilst in on exchange
2. As a participant in the scheme, the student has the responsibility of a young ambassador to Germany, where it will be his/her privilege to represent his/her school, family and Australia for approximately 9 weeks.
3. This is a FRIENDSHIP EXCHANGE. Its main objective is not to extend formal education but to provide a unique educational and social experience in broad sense and to promote self-awareness, maturity and responsibility in the participating student.
4. In case of difficulties in Germany, your contact person in the first instance is the supervising teacher at your German school.
5. The Landherr/Thumm Foundation will pay the cost of airfares only. All other expenses must be paid by the parents, including an adequate amount of pocket money for the student.
6. It is the parent's responsibility to make arrangements for adequate accident, medical and travel insurance for the duration of their child's stay in Germany. Parents will be required to provide details of these arrangements to the organisers, prior to their child's departure from Australia.
7. It is the parent's responsibility to accurately complete the required health certificates and to return them to the organisers with the exchange application forms. These proforma have been approved by the Department of Education for use by students taking part in exchange programs of this type.
