School Reciprocal Attendance Agreement

Introduction

Since 2004, the Landherr-Thumm Foundation has sponsored a short-term student exchange program between host families and schools in Adelaide and Alzenau, Germany.

The Adelaide students stay in Germany for about 8 weeks during the summer holidays after their Year 10 or 11. The German students stay in Australia for approximately 10 weeks during July/September of their Year 10 or 11 (i.e. during their summer holidays).

The exchange program follows the guidelines established by the South Australian Department of Education and Child Development, and is a short-term “cultural exchange”.

Students are accommodated with a host family and attend classes and other activities at the co-operating exchange school. The program is legally a family-to-family arrangement, with the host family being fully responsible for the exchanged students (i.e. “in loco parentis”).

The school(s) in Alzenau allow attendance free-of-charge for the students from Australia.

This purpose of this document is to record that the Adelaide school will also allow attendance free-of-charge to the German exchange student named below.
